Assistance with Travel/Transport:

Travelling by Yourself:

If your condition makes it uncomfortable or impossible for you to use conventional modes of transport or even public transport, then we will help you gain access to taxis, rideshares, community transport, and other suitable transport methods.

Travel Assistance:

Through the NDIS Yahweh care also provides funding that will allow you to hire a support worker to drive you around and even accompany you in your travel. Whether it be shopping, social events, or transport for your medical appointments, our transport and travel assistance will be with you.

NDIS PLAN MANAGEMENT

Our Services:

Yahweh NDIS Plan Management services are here to support you and make keeping track of your NDIS finances easier, safer, and more effective.

What is an NDIS plan manager?

Under NDIS Plan Management, your Plan Manager will help take the stress out of managing your finances and the day-to-day administration of your NDIS plan. Your NDIS Plan Manager provides you with support and security and is also known as a Financial Intermediary.



NDIS PLAN MANAGEMENT

NDIS Plan Management includes:

- Organising payments to your NDIS providers.
- Helping you to keep track of your NDIS funds and spending.
- Taking care of NDIS financial reporting requirements.

Our Services will:

- Support you to get the most out of your NDIS plan.
- Take away your worries about financial administration.
- Ensure your providers are paid correctly and on time
- Allocate you a Finance and Consumer Service Officer as an easy point of contact if you have any questions.



NDIS PLAN MANAGEMENT

NDIS Plan Management Costs:

If Plan Management is already included in your NDIS plan, then there is no cost to you when you use NDIS Plan Management services. Make sure you specifically ask for Plan Management (or Financial Intermediary) to be included in your NDIS plan at your planning meeting.

What other options are available to manage my NDIS Plan finances?

NDIS Plan Management (Financial Intermediary) is just one way to manage the finances in your NDIS plan. You are in control and can choose from a range of different ways to manage the financial aspects of your NDIS plan.



NDIS PLAN MANAGEMENT

These other options include:

- NDIA (Agency) Managed Plans
- Self-Managed Plans
- A combination of the above, including NDIS Plan Management.

Plan Management is a popular option for a lot of people as it offers more flexibility and choice, making managing your funds easy and less time-consuming.

Our Services:

At Yahweh Care we have a number of comfortable short-term accommodation properties available for our participants. We make sure that our participants get an opportunity to meet new people and feel at home away from home.

Our participants get to try new activities like:

- Watching movies
- Visiting shopping centres
- Having a meal at a nearby café
- Walking to the beach
- Playing a sport
- Checking local attractions.

Our consultants make sure that all our participant's individual needs are met. These include taking care of:

- Participant's medication timings and needs.
- Participant's personal needs like bathing and
- dressing
- Participant's meal preparation and cooking
- Participant's dietary requirements.

We also provide the above-mentioned support in the comfort of your own home if you do not wish to stay in our properties.

Length of Stay:

Our participants have the option of staying at our property for their desired period of stay from a day to a month as per their NDIS funding.

Support for Children and Adults:

We provide support to children and adults both and so our participants stay with others of their age making them more comfortable.

Specialist Disability Accommodation (SDA)

SDA is one of the supports that may be funded under the NDIS for some participants who have an extreme functional impairment or very high support needs. SDA refers to accommodation for people who require specialist housing solutions, including to assist with the delivery of supports that cater to their extreme functional impairment or very high support needs. SDA does not refer to the support services, but the homes in which these are delivered. SDA may, for example, have specialist designs for people with very high needs or a location or features that make it feasible to provide complex or costly supports for independent living.

We have a special surprise for everyone, our very own SDA accommodation will be finished this 1st week of August 2023.



RESPIRE CARE & SHORT-TERM ACCOMMODATION SDA

3 categories will be available:

- Improved Livability - Housing that has been designed to improve 'Liveability' by incorporating a reasonable level of physical access and enhanced provision for people with sensory, intellectual or cognitive impairment.
- Fully Accessible - Housing that has been designed to incorporate a high level of physical access provision for people with significant physical impairment.
- High Physical Support - Housing that has been designed to incorporate a high level of physical access provision for people with significant physical impairment and requiring very high levels of support.
- The property at 16 Metella Road, Toongabbie, NSW, 2146 was acquired with the intention of developing another such group home that could accommodate a community of individuals with disabilities. Listed as a Zone R2 Low Density Residential area, the plot is located in an outer north-western suburb, approximately 30 km from the Sydney GPO and 6 km east of Blacktown. It is within close proximity to schools and civic buildings, with the Toongabbie Bus/Rail Interchange and various sporting fields situated within a 500 m radius from the property.

SUPPORT COORDINATION

Our Services:

Transitions such as moving out of one's home, joining a university, or getting a job are part of everyone's life. It is never an easy task both emotionally and practically, and it becomes a little more difficult for people with disabilities.

Change can be hard as with it comes new environments and settings. Through an NDIS assisted life stage transition, we can enable a friction free move and encourage the participant to relocate in a new setting and create a comfortable ethos - accommodation, social connections, finances, and recreation for them to feel at ease.



SUPPORT COORDINATION

Common Life Transition services include:

Transitions such as moving out of one's home, joining a university, or getting a job are part of everyone's life. It is never an easy task both emotionally and practically, and it becomes a little more difficult for people with disabilities.

- Support connection and coordination
- Capacity building skills
- Development of independent self-care and living skills
- Crisis and conflict resolution
- Daily planning and Budgeting
- Establish supportive networks in the participant's communal setup.
- Linkage support to other supportive community services and programs
- Assistance with accommodation, tenancy procedures
- Daily planning and budgeting
- Mentoring and peer support
- Assistance with decision making and planning.
